Letter From The Pastor

January 2025

Thank you to all who helped bring about a wonderful start to the Christmas season on Christmas Eve.

No I'm not confused (at least about this.) The Christmas season starts in Christianity on December 25th ending on Epiphany, January 6th. This is traditionally said to be the day the Magi visit Jesus in Bethlehem. In previous centuries January 6th was the day to exchange gifts to mark the end of the season. Some cultures still follow this practice.

We won't be exchanging gifts but will be celebrating Epiphany on Sunday the 5th (since the 6th is Monday.) During the service those who wish can pick a "star word" — an intentions or guiding words for the new year. We are sharing in this prayer practice connected to Epiphany for the third year. You will have the chance to randomly pick from the available stars. Your star word could be something that God is leading you to discover, deepen, let go of, or sit with over the next months. Put is someplace you'll regularly see it (I put mine on my home computer) to remind you to regularly listen to how God might be using the word to speak in your life.

The practice is inspired by the story of the Magi who saw a star that ultimately led them to Jesus. We use these paper stars to remember God uses multiple ways to guide us and speak to us, by practicing looking for God in our midst, both actively and in hindsight. They may also inspire us to see God in the world and our lives in new ways.

If you would like a star and are unable to be with us on the 5th, please contact me. I will randomly pick a star for you and mail it or put it aside until you can pick it up.

At Christmas we celebrate that the Light has come into the world as one of us. Star words remind us that Light is still with us; sometimes we just need to remember to look.


