Letter From The Pastor

Worship Time Change Starting July 6, 2025

Worship time will be at 10:30am for the next twelve months.

I am happy to report that after a year of hard work and prayer by the task force to review the congregation's current Constitution and By-laws, it is time for the congregation to vote on accepting the revisions. To that end we will be holding a Special Church Meeting after worship on Sunday, July 27, 2025.

For those who have not had a chance to review these changes, drafts of the proposed changes as well as an overview summary are available on the same table as bulletins in the church, or by contacting the church office.

The task force held two informational sessions introducing the changes, discussing the process and answering questions. There were two questions that came up repeatedly. Below I expand on the answers I provided for those who might also wonder about these things.

1) The proposed By-laws combine most boards and committees into the Consistory. This means that there would no longer be Elders. So who can serve communion? Don't we need Elders to do this according to the UCC?

The short answer is no, there is no requirement in the UCC.

The longer answer is still no. This tradition of Elders as the only servers alongside the pastor for communion comes from the biblical tradition in the early church. Then communion was part of each week's gathering around a full meal. It was incorporated as part of the meal, passing of the communal cup and bread that were also present at any shared meal during the week. These weekly meals were attended by followers from a range of social and economic statuses.

The disciples, noting that too often those of higher social or economic status would insist on going first, over fill and leave little to nothing the rest, began appointing Deacons (what some churches came to call Elders.) It was the Deacons responsibility to ensure that those who might be pushed aside were served their fair share of the whole meal.

As the act of communion became separated from a full meal, high liturgy or pastor centered traditions began to associate Deacons or Elders as the being the ones either worthy or rightly trained to serve communion alongside the pastor. Sometimes they would be and still are held to higher standards that the rest of the membership: for example required to attend each week plus holy days, be part of weekly bible studies or prayer sessions, and/or maintain a "tithe" of giving 10% of their income to the church (or higher) proven by making their yearly income known to the Pastor or to the other Deacons/Elders.

In the German Evangelical and Reformed traditions that became part of the UCC there is a tradition of "ordained" Elders being the ones who prepare and serve communion with the Pastor. Each congregation can choose how they want to do this along with their pastor.

However, this is ultimately each congregation's decision.

2) What is this new membership classification "Emeritus Member"? Is this just a fancy way that keeps a long time member who can't come any more from being a member?

NO! In fact it is the opposite. It is a way to honor and appreciate the service to the congregation of members who due to age or infirmity can no longer attend, contribute or participate in the life of the church.

This was my idea (Pastor Deb) to honor our long term members, without forcing us to move them to inactive. I don't know if any other church does this. It is based on my experience of churches designating a previous pastor as a Pastor Emeritus- usual one who had significant impact on the life of the church- often the founding pastor or one who has gotten them through a time of significant change or challenge. This is an honorary title bestowed upon a pastor who has retired or concluded their active service to a church, while still being recognized for their past leadership and spiritual guidance. This designation acknowledges the pastor's faithful service and allows them to maintain a connection with the church without the responsibilities of active ministry.

The congregation regularly reviews membership rolls and reaches out to those who have not participated in a certain period of time inquiring if the individual wishes to continue their member. If there is no response or they request removal from the rolls because they can no longer participate and aren't able to join another church, then the Consistory can decide to instead designate them as Emeritus Member. This assumes that they have not been able to exercise their voice and vote in a significant time and will not regain this ability (it doesn't take away any voice or vote but acknowledges an ongoing reality.) However it allows them access to the same pastoral services as a member, including but not limited to pastoral visits, funerals, and other congregational support as a member. Anyone who is still supporting, actively participating in the life of the congregation or attending services cannot be moved to this designation – just as they could not be designated as inactive. If you have other questions or comments, please reach out to members of the task force.




