Letter From The Pastor

At last Sunday's Special Congregational meeting the congregation accepted the updated Constitution and Bylaws. Here are a few details from the process.

1) Thank you to the task forces that worked on this. First a small group reflected on the Purpose Statement in the Constitution. Thank you Karen Knospe, Jessica Osburn, and Stephen Prussing. The new one is:

We are United by our Christian faith, as a Church who worships, learns, and serves together while we follow Christ into our community and world.

2) Then a larger group started meeting in late fall and spent the winter and spring reflecting together, discussing what might need to be updated within each portion of each of these documents. Thank you to Linda Clark, Erick Hoffmaster, Karen Knospe, Cheryl Kuhn, Karen Pehler, Dave Schaffner, Dale and LuAnn Schmidtknecht and John Stettler.

They asked questions such as:

- a) How do our requirements for membership welcome new people, support current members and be faithful to the new Purpose Statement?
- b) What form of governance provides for accountability as well as simplicity in the oversight and administration of the ministries of the congregation? At the same time, how do we nurture participation by members and allow space for the development of new ministries by members as God leads us in the future?

There were several reasons for undertaking this process. One was the one that many congregations of all forms are experiencing; that we don't have as many members as when it was last revised.

Secondly, people who are part of churches are different than twenty years ago. Then they wouldn't have had a smartphone in their pocket when they came (both Apple and Android came out after it was previously revised). Other changes have taken place in our culture, society and churches as equally impactful on our faith life as the introduction of the smartphone has been on our habits.

There is a third reason, and the one I'm most excited about: this will allow more members to become active in the ministries and areas of church life that previously required a being a committee or Board member. The congregation can be nimbler in responding when we hear God speaking to us, and where we believe Christ is leading us in a particular moment. Major congregational decisions -such as major capital changes to the building, pastoral changes, and budget expenditures -will still be made by the wider congregation.

The Consistory is accountable for assuring the necessary and faith growing tasks of the congregation are getting done, as well as appropriate steps are being taken to live out the congregation's vision. They won't be required to be responsible for doing the tasks- though as individuals certainly can take on any they choose. So, we still need people to help maintain and clean the church, teach Sunday School, set up and serve Communion, usher and all the other vital parts of church life. This also frees up time and energy for members to explore new possibilities for carrying out the congregation's vision as laid out in Annual and Special Meetings. The Consistory will be accountable for oversight of these between Congregational Meetings.

There will most likely be some transitional bumps as we live into these changes. And a real possibility that something might get missed. If you notice something isn't being done that needs doing (or if something is being done that shouldn't be happening) please let a member of the Consistory or myself know. (Members of the new Interim Consistory are listed later in this newsletter.)

Blessing Of The Animals

Joint Service Invitation

Join us as St. John's Church and Hope United Church comes together for the Annual Pet Blessing Service at Fountain City Park at 10:30am. Bring pet as we give thanks for all God's creatures. The service will be followed by a potluck.

Pet Blessing services began as a way to honor Francis of Assi, who was known for his love of all God's Creation, from animals to plants to the stars themselves. Stories tell of Francis preaching to attentive ravens, as well as convincing a wolf not to eat the citizens of a village. He is also known for the "Canticle of the Creatures", his work with the poor and lepers, and the founding of the Franciscan Order.

Pastor Deb will bless any animal. They must be in a crate/cage/similar closed container or on a leash/lead. This is for the safety of all the animals as well as people attending. Please also bring with you supplies to clean up any "offerings" you animal might make, though we will have few available.

If you don't feel comfortable bringing your pet or animal, or they are too large to transport for the service, you are invited to bring something that represents them for blessing in their stead. This may be a collar, saddle, lead, blanket, or other item that you associate with your pet or animal. Pastor Deb will also bless any stuffed "animals" that a child might have if desired. There will be dog and cat treats available, as well as a potluck after. This will be the only service for this day for Hope United Church and St. John's Church.




