Letter From The Pastor

September 2024

I am looking for a few volunteers to help the congregation to continue to move forward in your ministry.

The Consistory needs for 5-10 volunteers to take part in reviewing and updating the By-laws and Constitution to reflect the church's current context. The last update to the church's Constitution and By-laws was almost twenty years ago. Longtime members, newer members, and confirmed youth and young adults are encouraged to become part of this process. The review and proposal of changes to the Purpose Statement of the Constitution has already been completed by a task group of 3 members facilitated by me.

The first meeting will be a 3-4 hour retreat to reflect together to discern what it means to be church today, to be a member of a church, and leadership styles that nurture and enable congregations to follow God's purposes for the congregation.

My experience is that the retreat will lead to less time and meetings needed for the rest of the process. If a sufficient number of people are willing to be part of this vital work for the life of the congregation, the group will be divided into two groups, one focusing on membership and the other governance. After that is completed, the entire group would review and draft any needed updates to the rest of these documents. Throughout the process the congregation will also be offered opportunities for input.

The initial goal is to have a draft ready for congregational approval by the 2025 Annual Meeting, but no later than spring 2025.

Steve Prussing shared with the Consistory that upon the recommendation of his doctor he needed to resign as President of the congregation. Steve's prognosis is good, and we will continue to hold Sue and him in our prayers as a congregation and personally as he continues his treatments.

Joint Service Invitation

Join us as St. John's Church and Hope United Church comes together for the Annual Pet Blessing Service at Goose Lake Park, next to Hope United Church in Cochrane at 10:30am. Bring pet as we give thanks for all God's creatures. The service will be followed by a potluck.

Pet Blessing services began as a way to honor Francis of Assi, who was known for his love of all God's Creation, from animals to plants to the stars themselves. Stories tell of Francis preaching to attentive ravens, as well as convincing a wolf not to eat the citizens of a village. He is also known for the "Canticle of the Creatures", his work with the poor and lepers, and the founding of the Franciscan Order.

Pastor Deb will bless any animal. They must be in a crate/cage/similar closed container or on a leash/lead. This is for the safety of all the animals as well as people attending. Please also bring with you supplies to clean up any "offerings" you animal might make, though we will have few available.

If you don't feel comfortable bringing your pet or animal, or they are too large to transport for the service, you are invited to bring something that represents them for blessing in their stead. This may be a collar, saddle, lead, blanket, or other item that you associate with your pet or animal. Pastor Deb will also bless any stuffed "animals" that a child might have if desired. There will be dog and cat treats available, as well as a potluck after. This will be the only service for this day for Hope United Church and St. John's Church.




